Board of Education Member Vacancy

The Prospect Park Board of Education announces there is a vacancy on the Board. The Board seeks to appoint a qualified individual to fill the vacancy. The term of office would be from the date of appointment continuing through the Organization Meeting of the Board in January 2022.

Qualifications, pursuant to law, to become a Board member are:

- Be able to read and write;
- Hold United States citizenship;
- Be a resident of the school district for one year or more;
- Be registered to vote in the district;
- Have no interest in any contract with, or claim against, the Board of Education;
- Not hold office as mayor or member of the municipal governing body;
- Not simultaneously hold two elective offices;
- Not be disqualified from membership for the conviction of certain crimes. (Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a criminal history background investigation through the state Department of Education.)
